About the Program

The six-month long program's objective is to stimulate and encourage minority and under-represented individuals' interests in professional healthcare programs by exposing qualified participants to the different doctorate degrees available. (Students selected for the program will represent minority (non-Caucasian or female), rural, economically disadvantaged, **and/or** first-generation students of any ethnicity.)

It is an extension of the Symposium and provides more detailed information about each discipline. Activities related to careers will be held once/month minimally. Participants will also have to participate in a group community service project and/or social event(s) during that time. Participants will be provided with ACT preparation and should have taken or be registered for a college entrance exam before the program's end. Student may also have to report school progress at every meeting. At the end of the Program cycle, students will be treated to an award ceremony. Once a student has completed the program, he/she may be asked to serve as volunteers (or Ambassadors) for the incoming class of students.

How can my child participate?

Since your child was a participant in the Symposium, another application **will not** have to be completed.
